It's Lent-- Let's Get Excited!

Dear St Paul's friends: This Wednesday, March 5, is Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the Christian Church's Lenten season. Too often people are tempted to dread Lent. It can seem on the surface to be a dreary time, both weather wise here where we live-- as well as spiritually. The church's focus on repentance can seem a heavy lift when we may feel overwhelmed already by challenges at home, work, or the community around us.

But Lent can also be an exciting time of spiritual renewal if we can be open to the challenge it places before us. We can treat Lent as a challenge of repenting and letting go of the past but also of accepting the gift of redemption and life offered to us through Jesus' death and resurrection. So this year I want us to strive to help us **get excited about Lent**. Instead of **enduring** Lent, I invite you to **embrace** Lent.

You can do this by making it a point to join our Sunday Eucharist, to pop into one of our Thursday bible studies on how to live the Beatitudes, giving something extra in time or money to a charitable need that speaks to your heart, or picking an individual spiritual discipline. The special services offered during Lent, especially those in Holy Week can be some of the most beautiful and spiritually meaningful of the entire year. #### It's LENT! Check out these Opportunities to Pray and Learn

The Lenten Season, consisting of approximately 5 weeks and 40 days, presents a fine opportunity to add a discipline of prayer or study to your daily routine. Lent is traditionally considered a period of fasting, prayer, penitence and giving. While many folks like to "give up" something for Lent, adding something can be equally spiritually enriching. Here are some resources and opportunities for study, individually or in fellowship with others here at St Paul's.

**Living Compass Guide:** The Living Compass Spirituality and Wellness Initiative of the Episcopal Church offers a guide to spiritual, mental, and physical wellness during Lent. Copies are available at no charge on the table by the entrance to the nave.

**Bible Study:** St Paul's will continue its in person bible study focussing on how to live the Beatitudes every other Thursday evening in the Guild Hall. We meet at 5 pm for light supper followed by a one hour time of fellowship and discussion from 5:30 to 6:30 pm. Upcoming Dates are March 13, March 27 and April 10. Come to one or all sessions.

**Episcopal Relief and Development**, our National Church's arm for justice and relief ministries around our country and world is sponsoring a daily meditation during Lent called "A Commonplace Lent". 


